Resort & Spa Mauritius. For lovers of Asian cuisine, there is a weekly duck festival at 'Le Banyan Asian Fusion restaurant', while diners at 'La Marée Beach Restaurant' can sample the day's catch with a personalised selection, cooked bespoke, at the 'Fish Market'. Those wanting to discover authentic Indian Ocean specialities, the multi-awarded Château Mon Désir, located on the hotel grounds, is widely regarded as the premier restaurant on the island.

Helping guests to indulge in some well-deserved rest and relaxation, the renowned Maritim Tropical Flower Spa, which recently scooped the 'World Luxury Spa Award', is an oasis dedicated to wellbeing set in the middle of 3500sqm of lush tropical gardens. Using rounded stones submerged in the water, which gradually decrease in size, guests walk barefoot as the stones stimulate foot pressure points, boosting circulation and wellbeing.

Sport lovers can enjoy the 9-hole (PAR 29) golf course on the hotel's grounds. Designed by the acclaimed Australian professional golfer Graham Marsh, the Maritim Golf Course a variety in length elevation and angle for wide range of shots and is ideal for all skill levels, from expert to beginner. Professional coaching is also available for those seeking help with their swing, putting and pitching.

Unique to the island is the 'Maritim Equestrian Centre',

located near the 'Historical Ruins of Balaclava'. The state of the art facility boasts numerous paddocks and is home to ten former Championship race horses. Guests can enjoy horse rides on the beach or through the natural wonders of the Maritim Estate, labelled the "Most Beautiful Garden of Mauritius".
